Please note that grant dollars **may not** be used to fund general operating costs, capital improvements, endowments, lobbying, or activities that exclusively benefit the members of a sectarian or religious organization.

Successful applicants will receive 75% of funding at the onset of project and the remaining 25% will be provided upon completion of project.

Your ideas should engage people in projects that create an inviting, vibrant, safe, healthy community where residents are proud of their environment. Project ideas should connect people to their past, to their neighbours, and to their community.
