

## 2020 Updates to Bylaws: Summary of Key Changes

	<b>Prior</b>	<b>Now</b>
<b>Types of Membership</b>	Individual Members (18+, didn't have to live in the neighbourhood) & Organizational Members	Resident Member (16+, lives in the neighbourhood) & Non-Resident Member (16+, doesn't live in the neighbourhood)
<b>Location of Meetings of Members</b>	Saskatchewan	Regina or virtually
<b>Quorum for Meetings of Members</b>	1/5 of voting members	1/5 of voting members OR 12 voting members, whichever is larger
<b>Number of Board Members</b>	5-12	5-11, and striving for an odd number to help prevent ties
<b>Tie-Breaking</b>	Chair could have a second vote	We have more discussion, and everyone votes a second time. If we're still tied, the issue is tabled until a future meeting.
<b>Board Composition</b>	No stipulation about resident/non-resident ratios	Must be comprised of a majority of Resident Members
<b>Making Decisions by Email</b>	No provision for making decisions by email	"Between meetings, decisions of a time-sensitive manner, can be discussed and voted on by email. A decision receiving the majority of support from Directors will be considered passed, and will be entered into the minutes of the next meeting of Directors."
<b>Signing Officers</b>	Implied that only board members could be signing officers, and that board members handle day-to-day banking	Added bookkeeper and staff to possible signing officers, and clarified that the ED and bookkeeper handle day-to-day banking, and signing officers "sign cheques, authorize e-transfers and other financial transactions, and sign financial documents."
